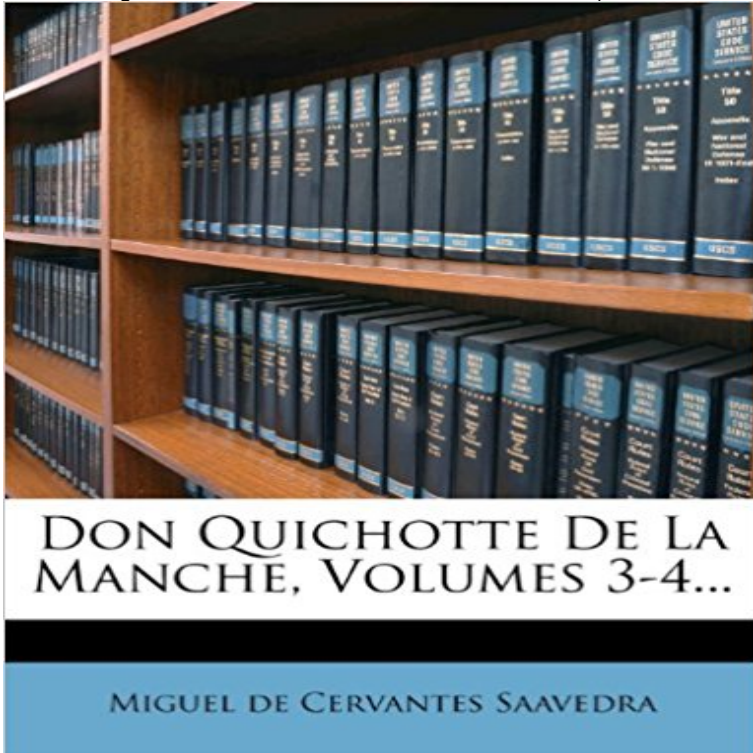


Don Quichotte De La Manche, Volumes 3-4... (French Edition)
