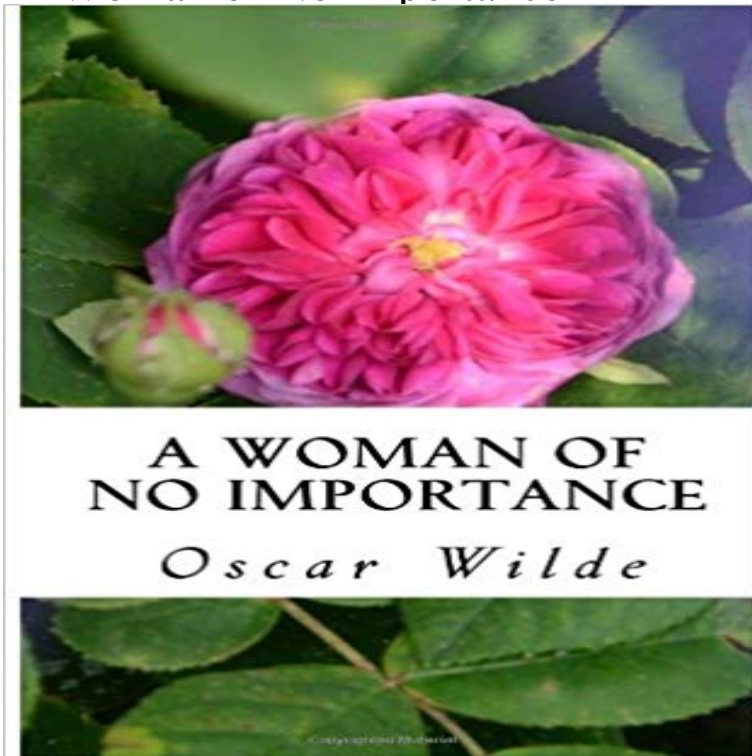


## A Woman of No Importance
