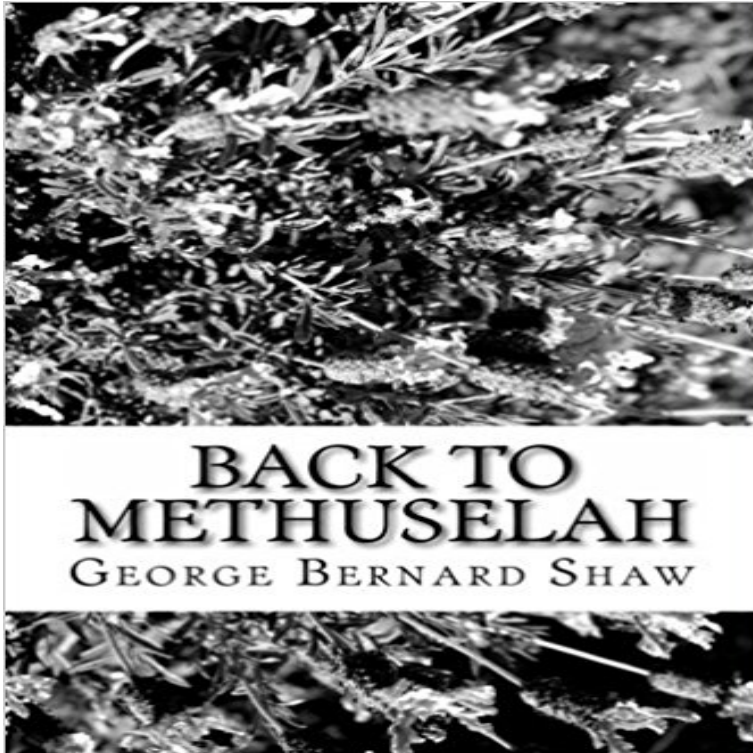


Back to Methuselah
