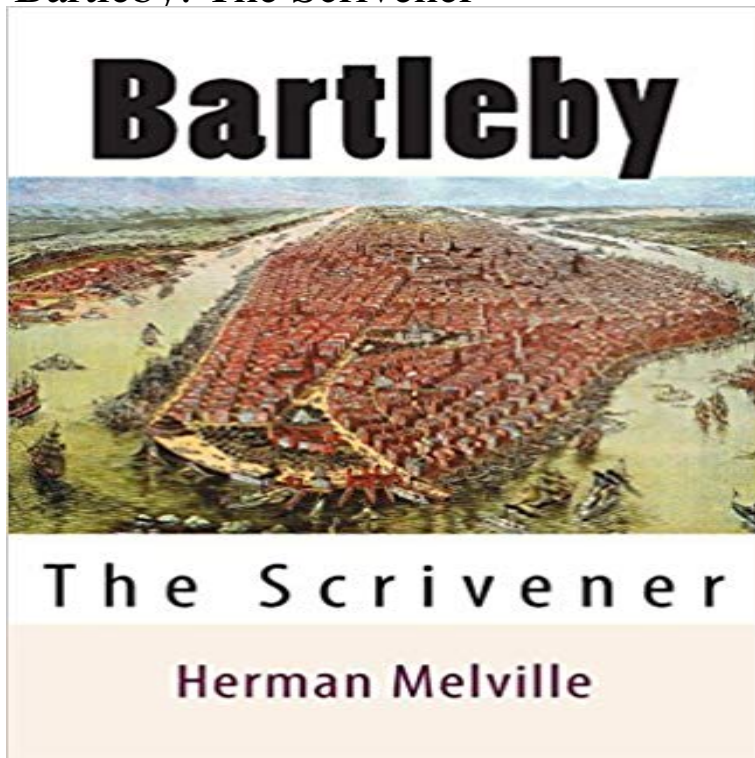


Bartleby: The Scrivener
