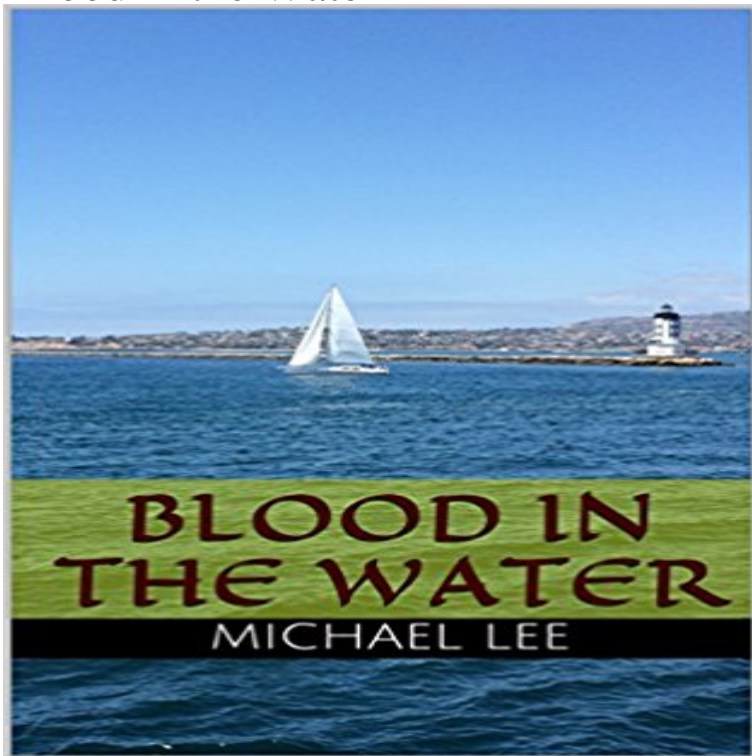


Blood in the Water
