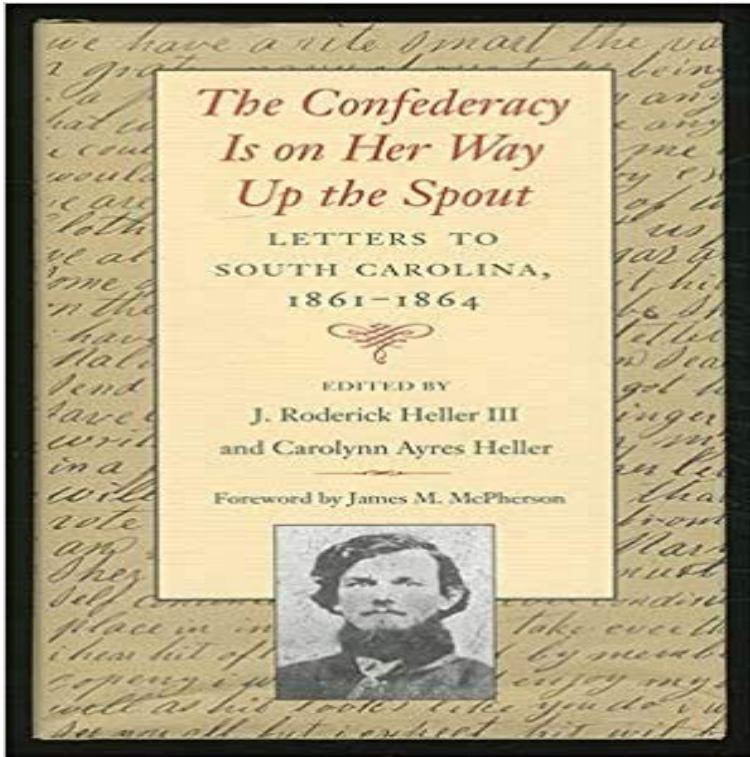


The Confederacy Is on Her Way Up the Spout: Letters to South Carolina, 1861-1864
