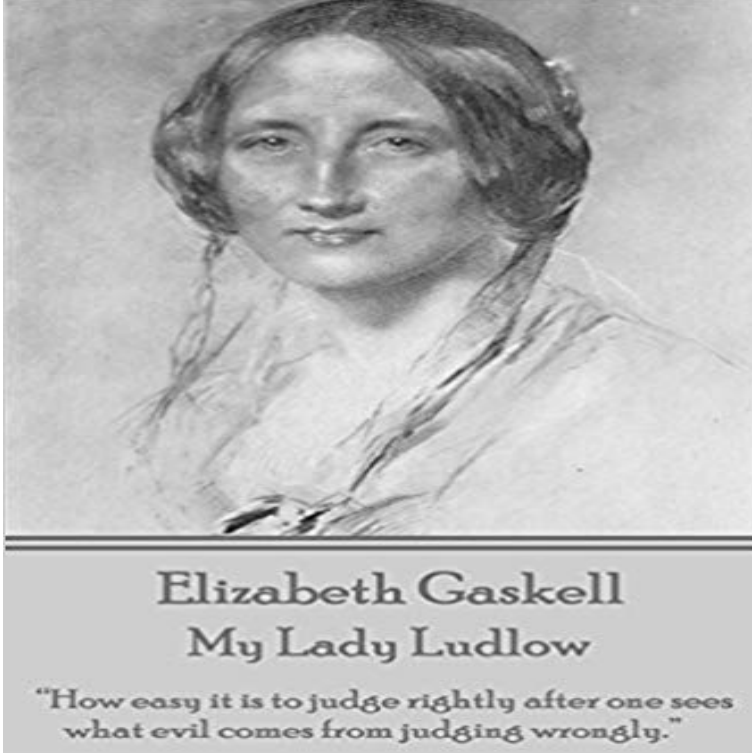


## Elizabeth Gaskell - My Lady Ludlow: How easy it is to judge rightly after one sees what evil comes from judging wrongly.
