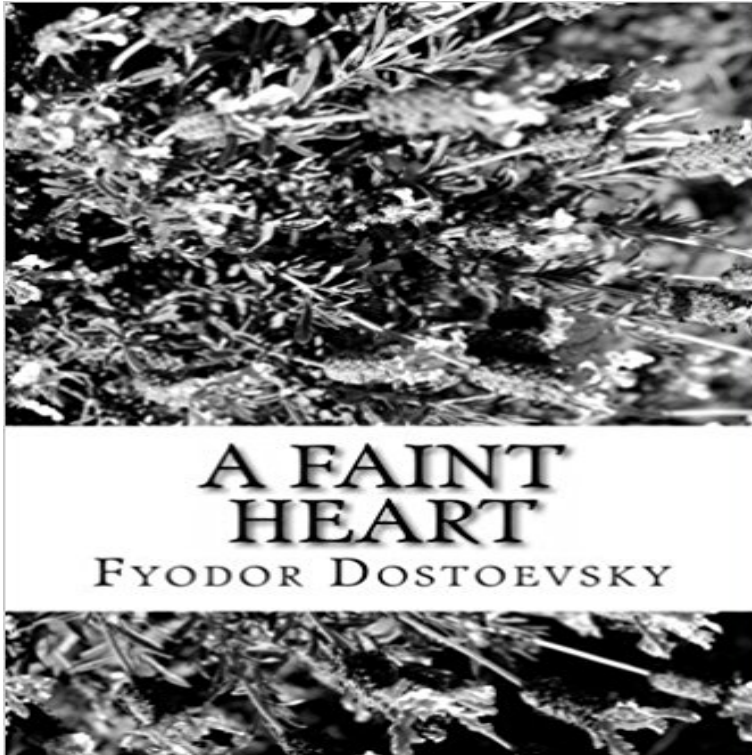


A Faint Heart
