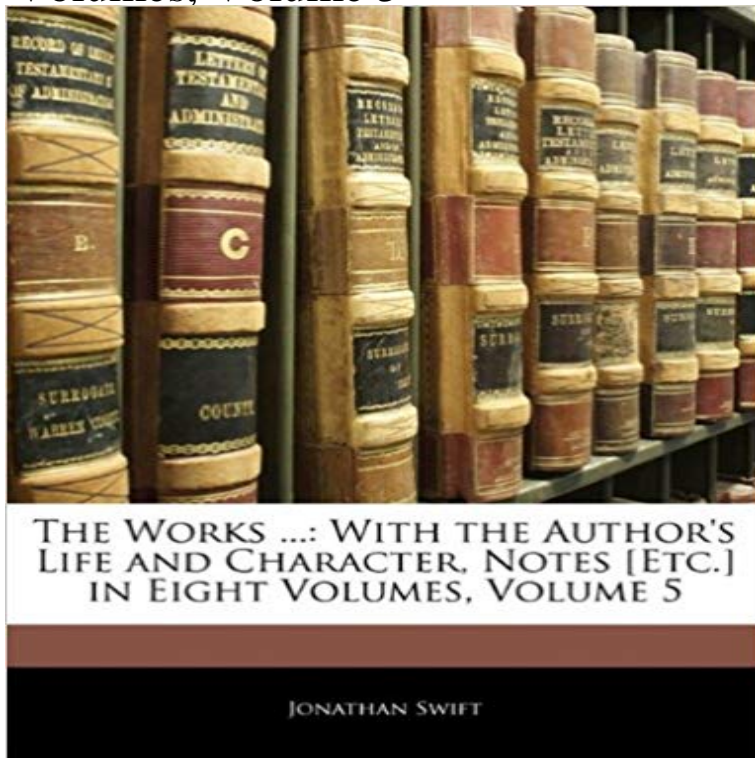


The Works ...: With the Authors Life and Character, Notes [Etc.] in Eight Volumes, Volume 5
