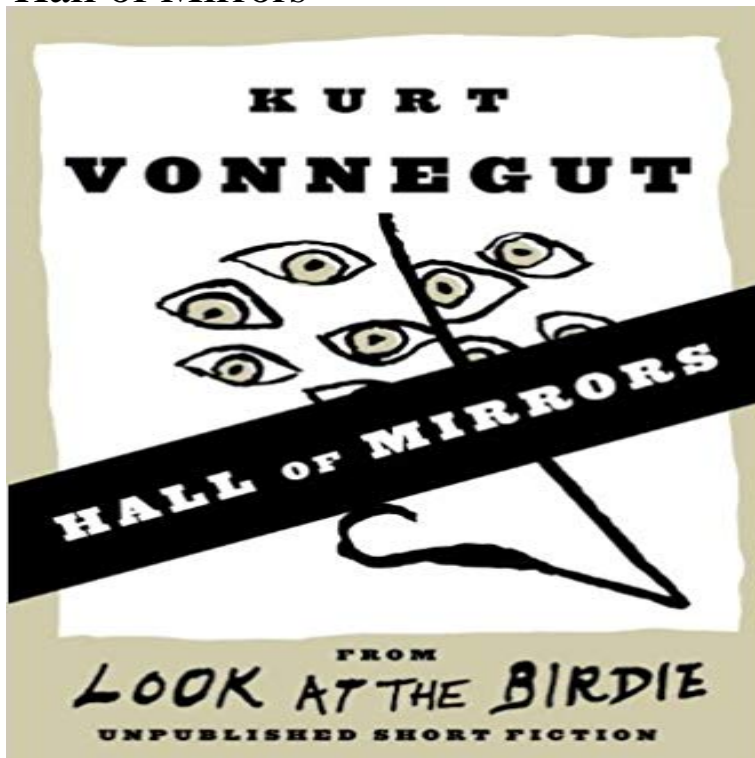


Hall of Mirrors
