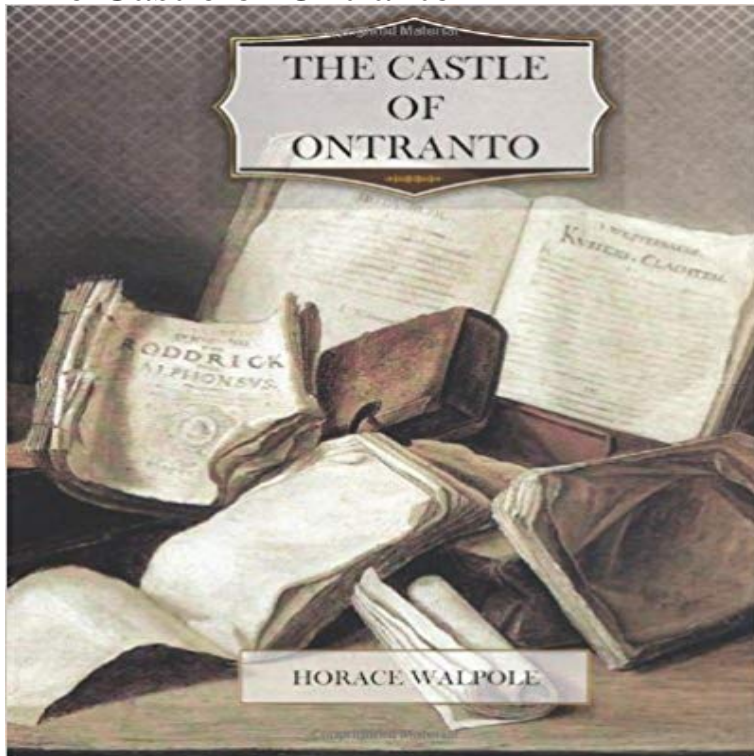


The Castle of Ontranto
