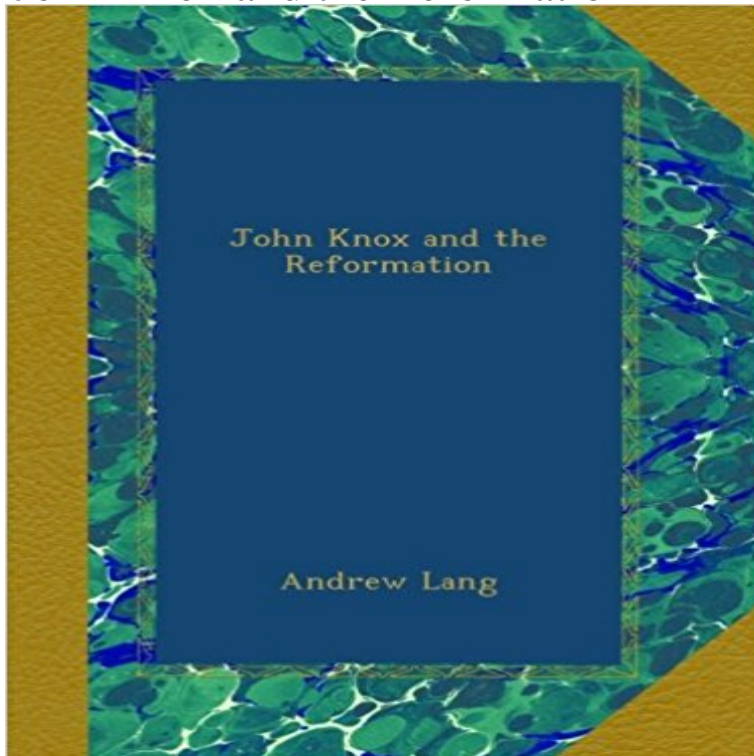


## John Knox and the Reformation
