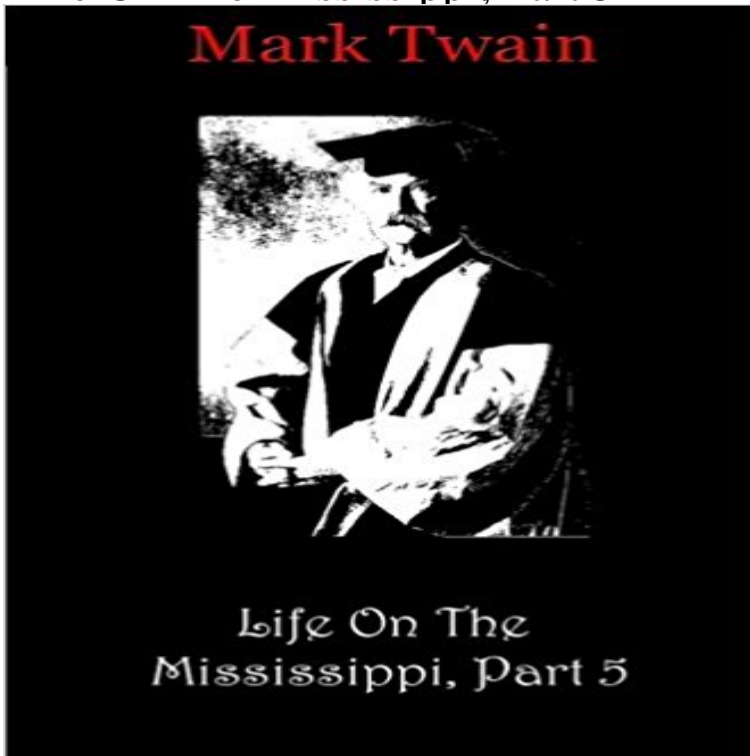


## Life On The Mississippi, Part 5
