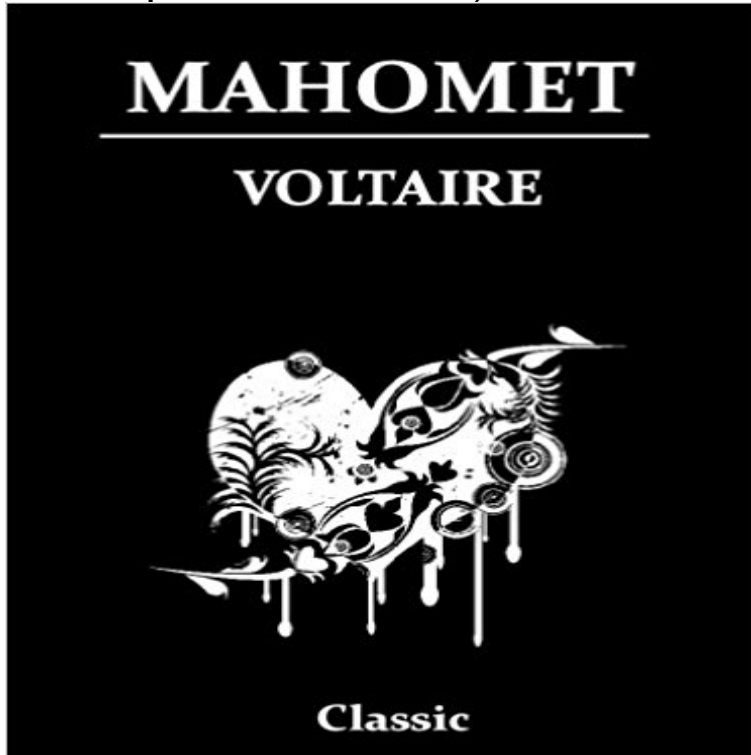

As a satirical polemicist, he frequently made use of his works to criticize intolerance, religious dogma and the French institutions of his day.
