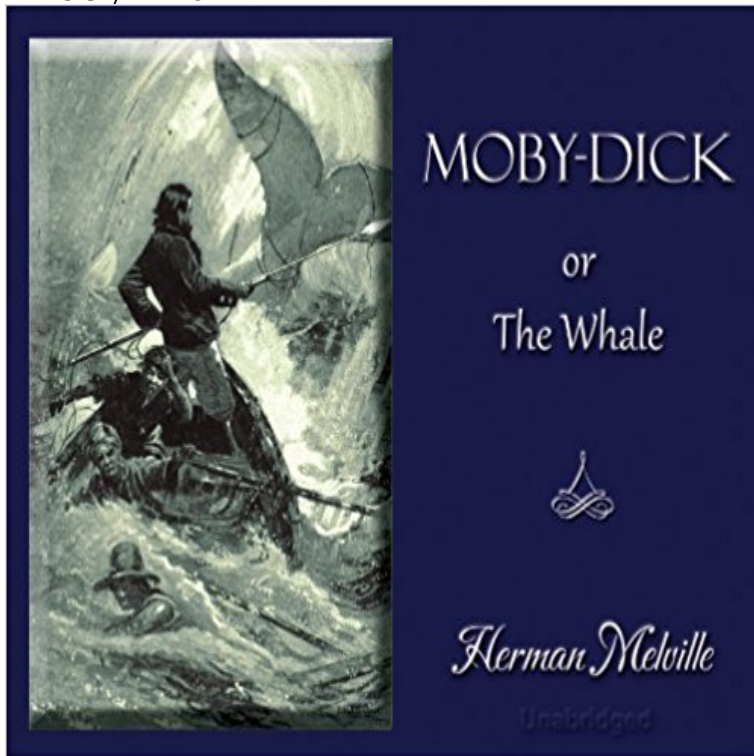


# Moby Dick

In a previous encounter, the whale destroyed Ahab's boat and bit off his leg and Ahab intends to take revenge. The first line, "Call me Ishmael," is one of the most famous opening lines in American literature.
