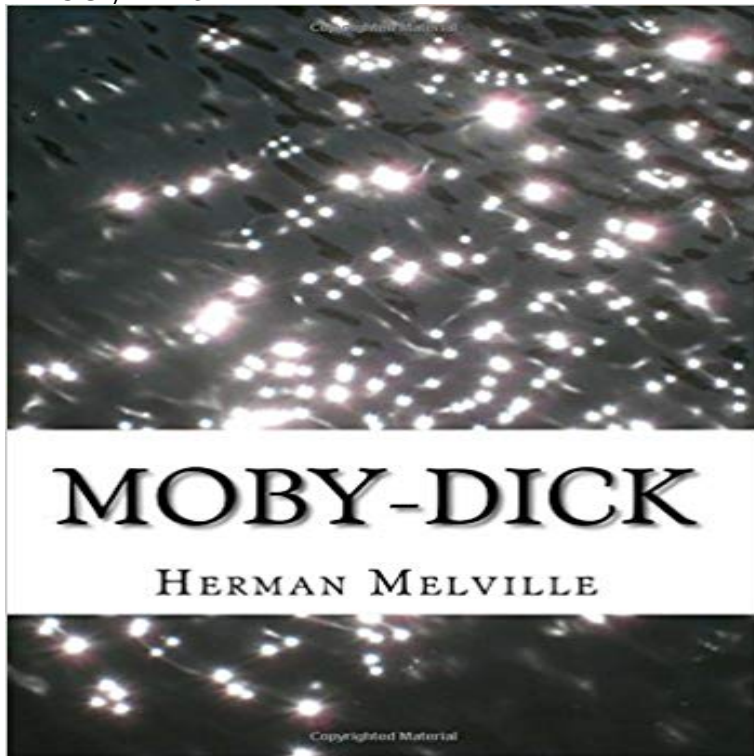


Moby Dick



Moby-Dick draws on Melville's experience onboard ships as well as his exposure to whaling books and influences that included the Bible and Shakespeare. Herman Melville took a year and a half to write this novel, which is considered an outstanding work of Romanticism and the American Renaissance. The novel was first published in London in October 1853 as *The Whale* and then under its better-known title *Moby-Dick* in New York that November. About 3,200 copies were sold during the author's lifetime, earning him a little more than \$1,200.
