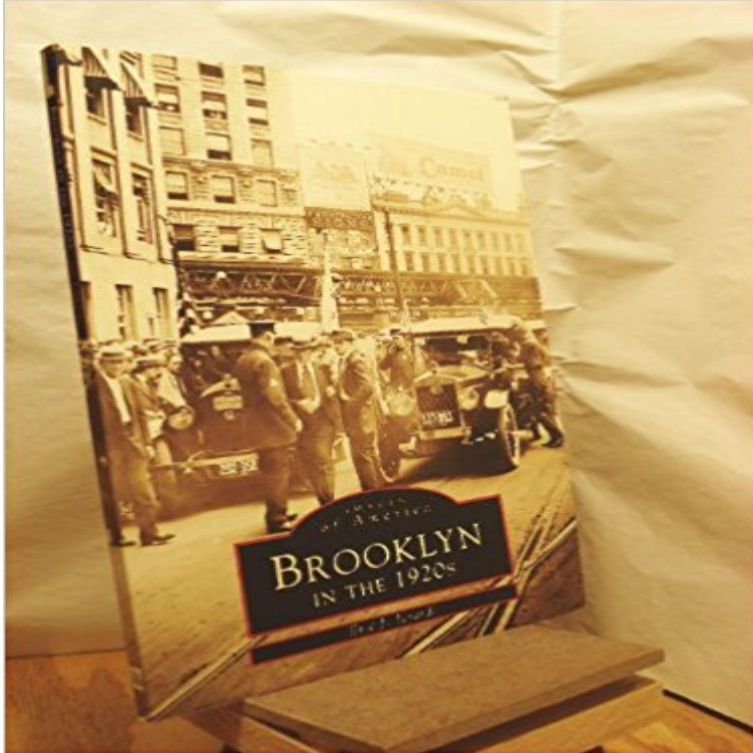


Brooklyn in the 1920s (Images of America)
