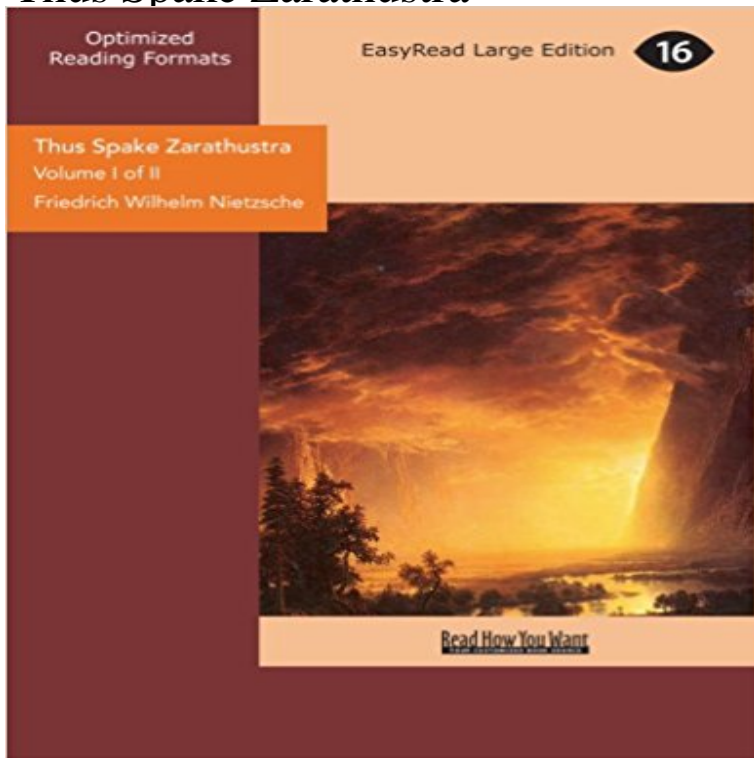


Thus Spake Zarathustra
