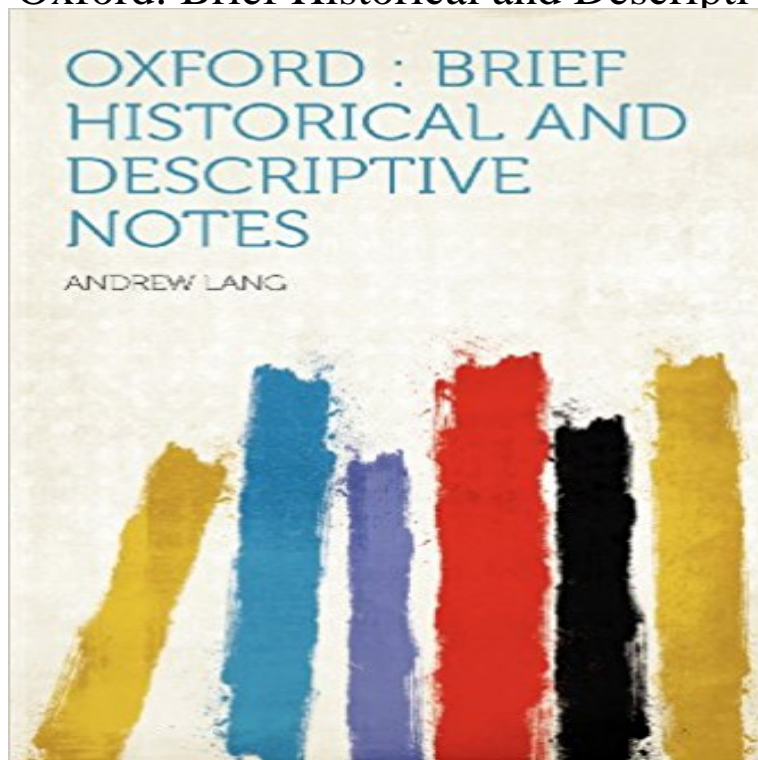


## Oxford: Brief Historical and Descriptive Notes
