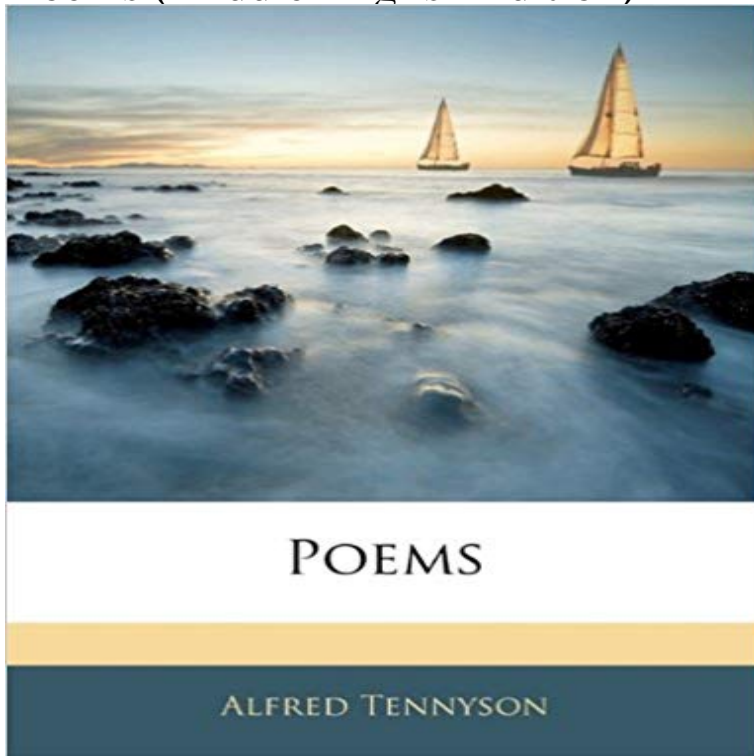


Poems (Middle English Edition)
