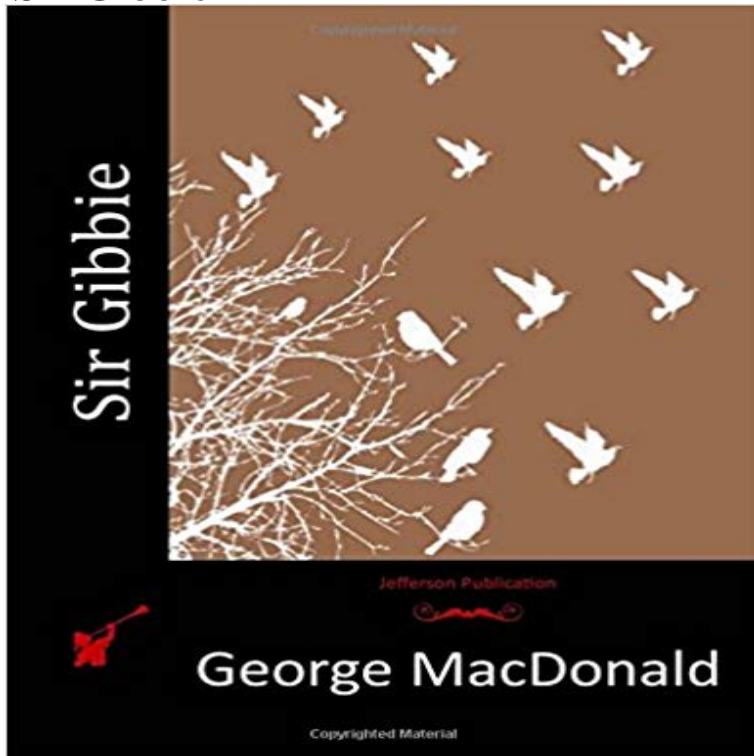


Sir Gibbie
