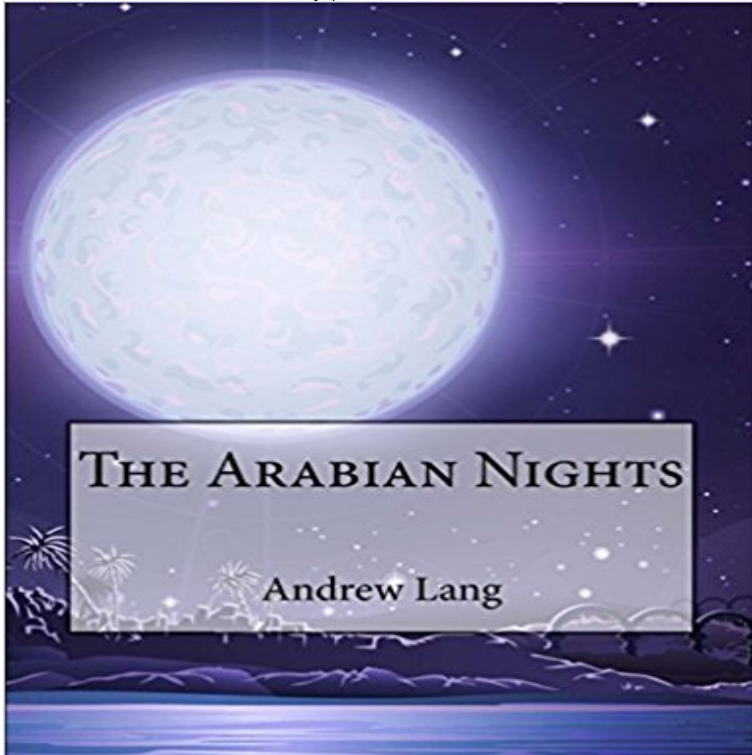


The Arabian Nights
