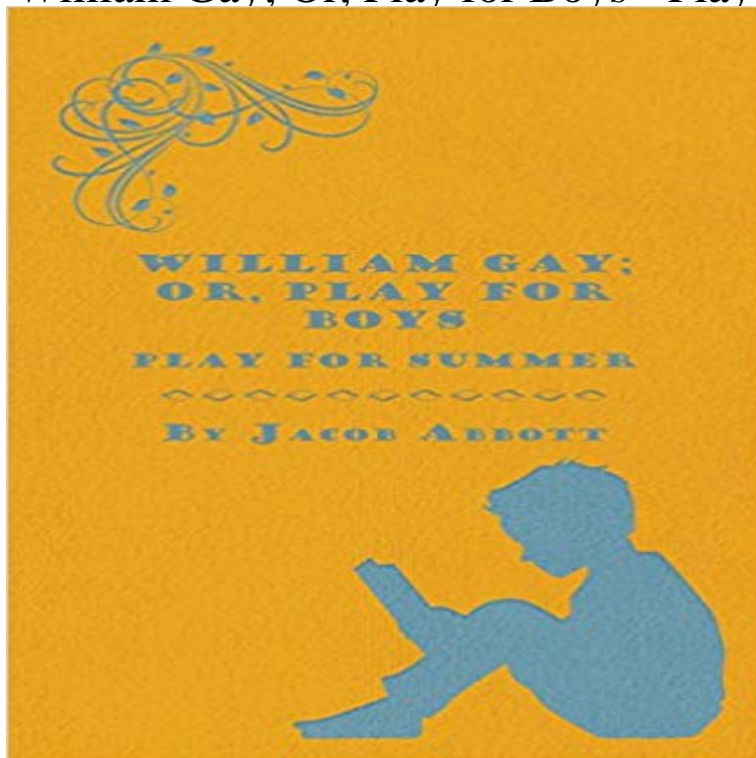


## William Gay; Or, Play for Boys - Play for Summer
