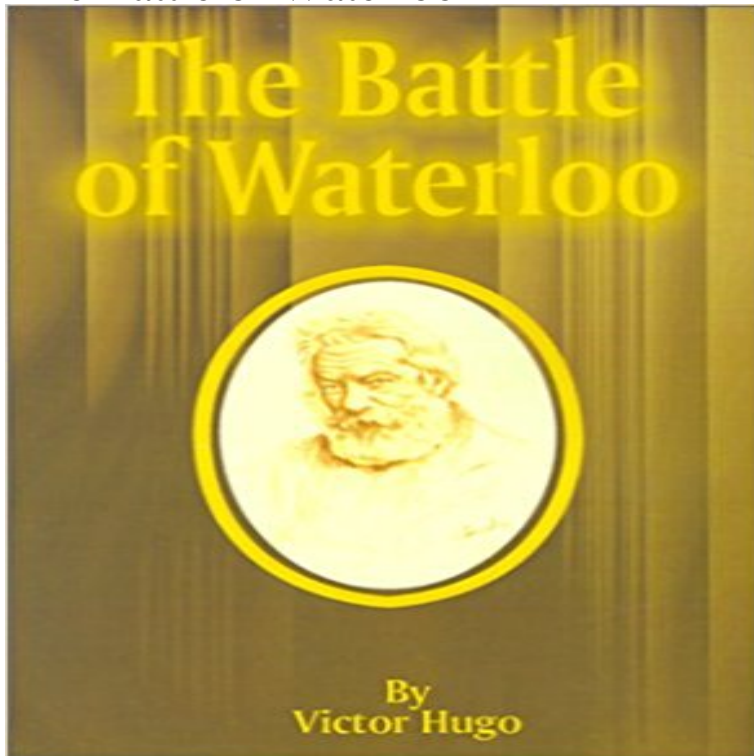


## The Battle of Waterloo
