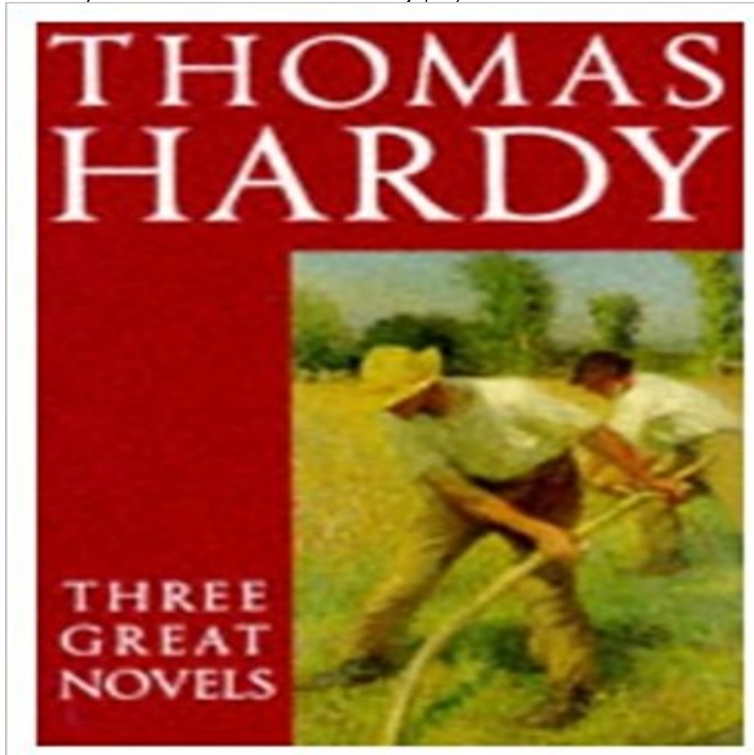


Thomas Hardy: Three Great Novels: Far from the Madding Crowd, The Mayor of Casterbridge, Tess of the dUrbervilles
