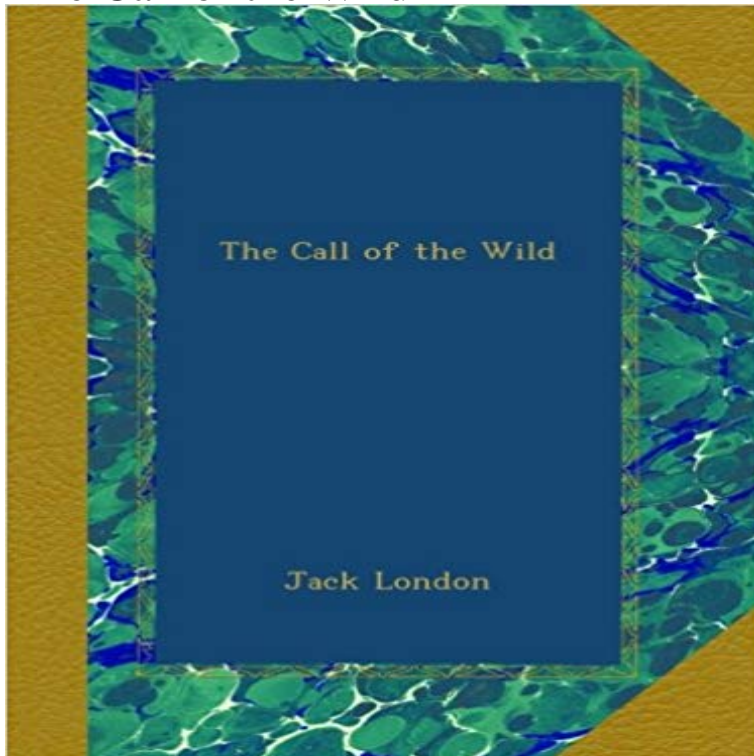


## The Call of the Wild
