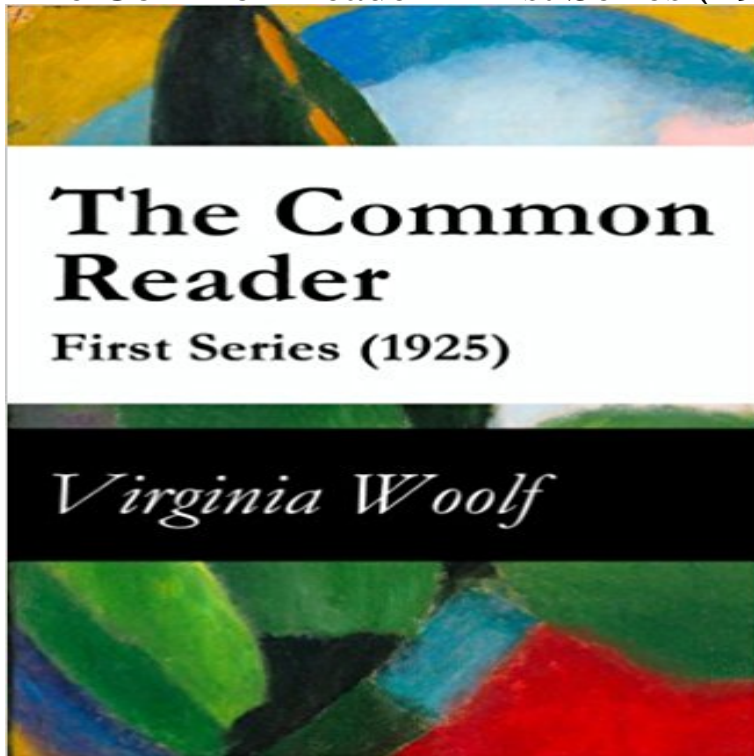


The Common Reader - First Series (1925)
