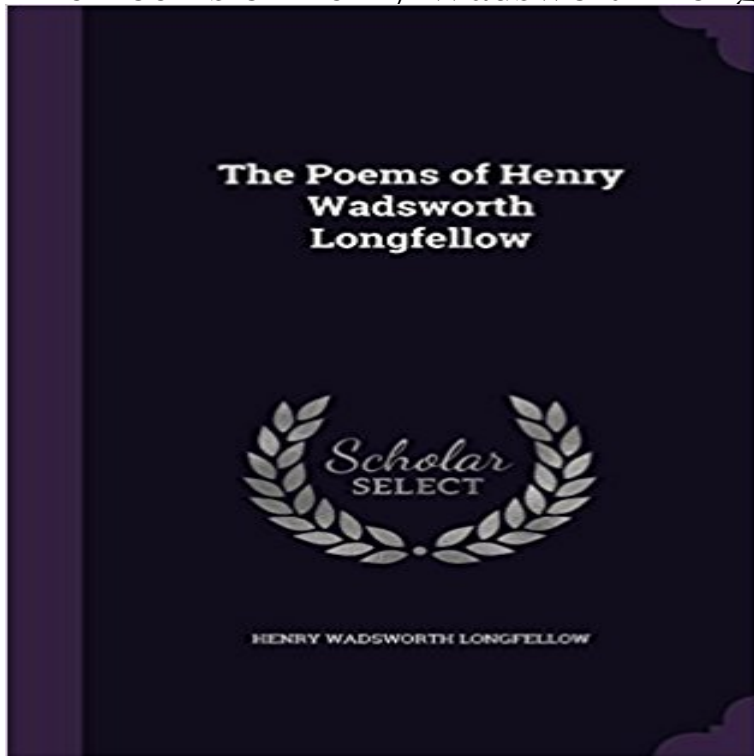


# The Poems of Henry Wadsworth Longfellow
