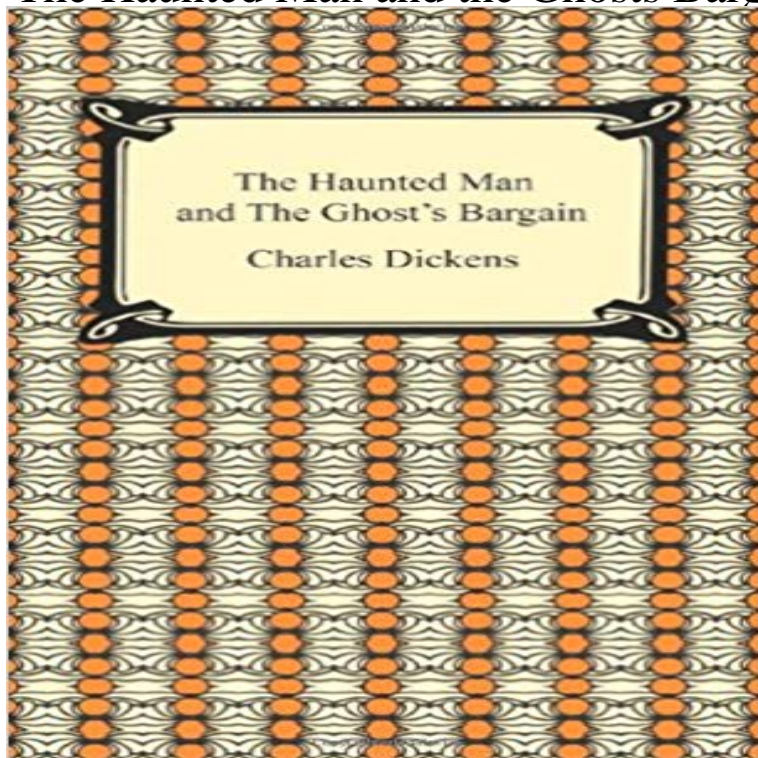


## The Haunted Man and the Ghosts Bargain

Ultimately the conflict of the novella is resolved in an uplifting way which asserts the moral of the story, that it is important to remember past sorrows and wrongs so that you can then forgive those responsible and, in doing so, unburden your soul and mature as a human being.
