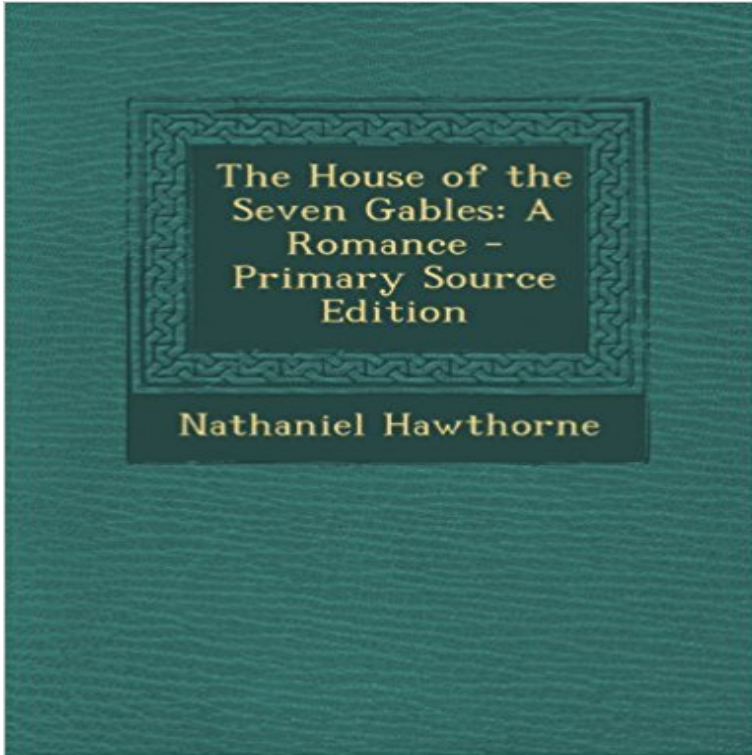


House of the Seven Gables: A Romance
