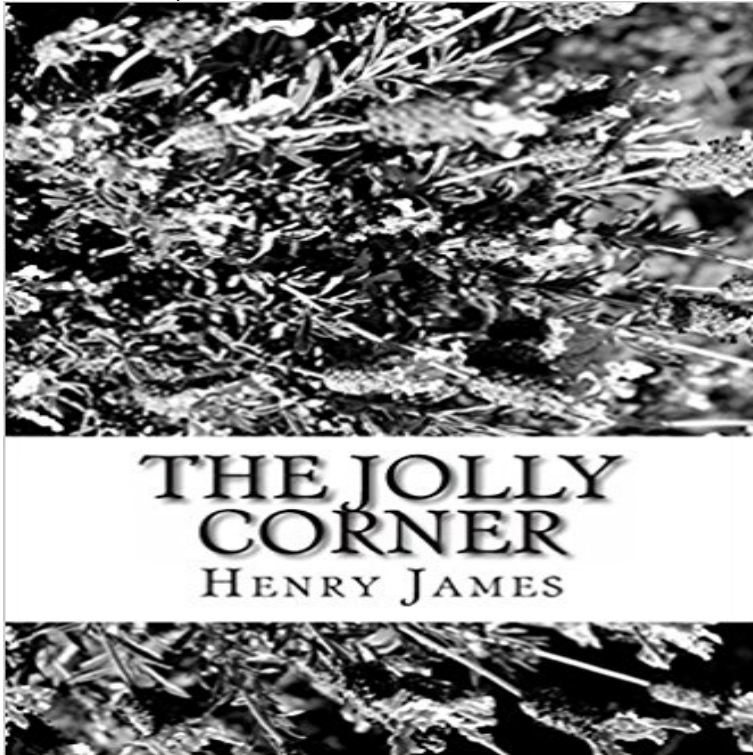


The Jolly Corner
