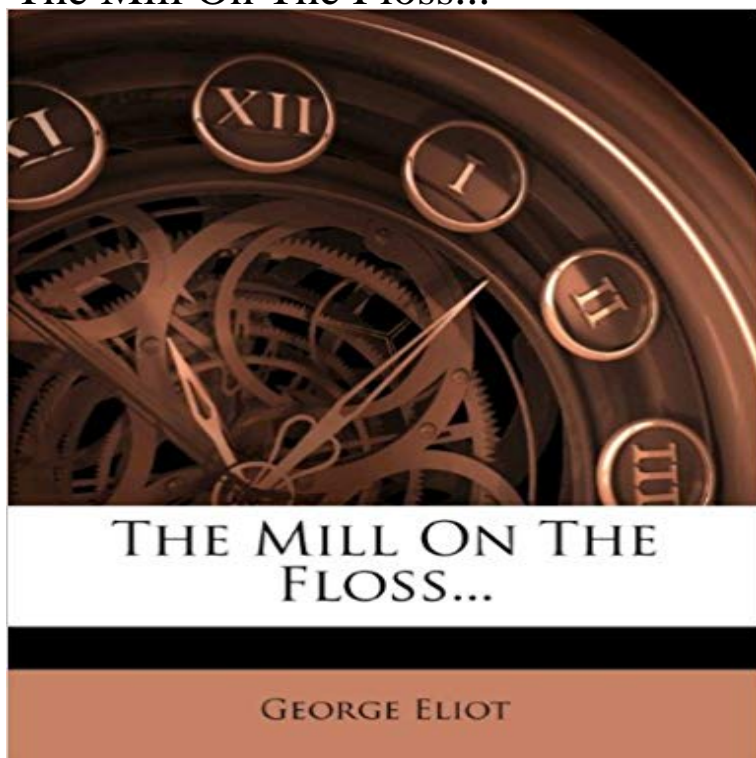


The Mill On The Floss...
