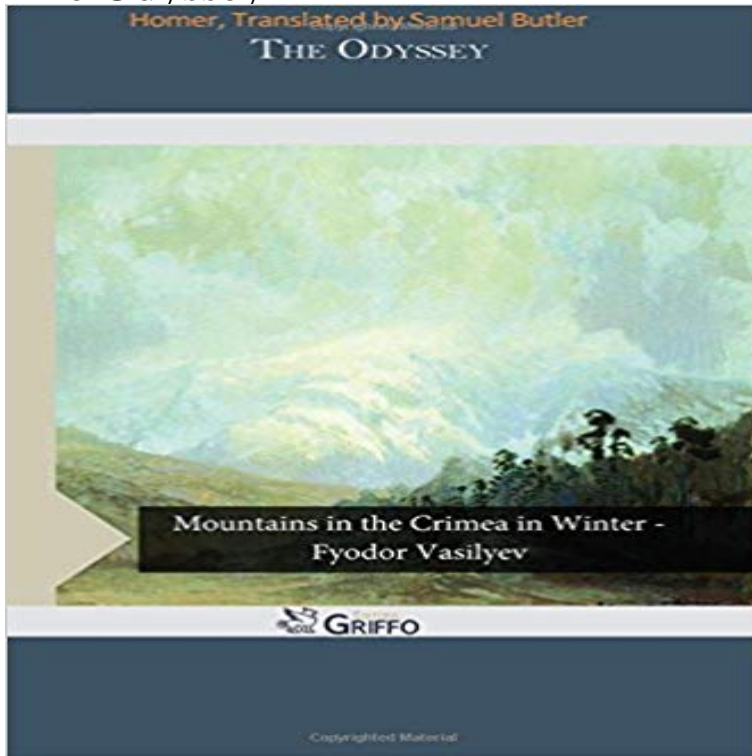


The Odyssey
