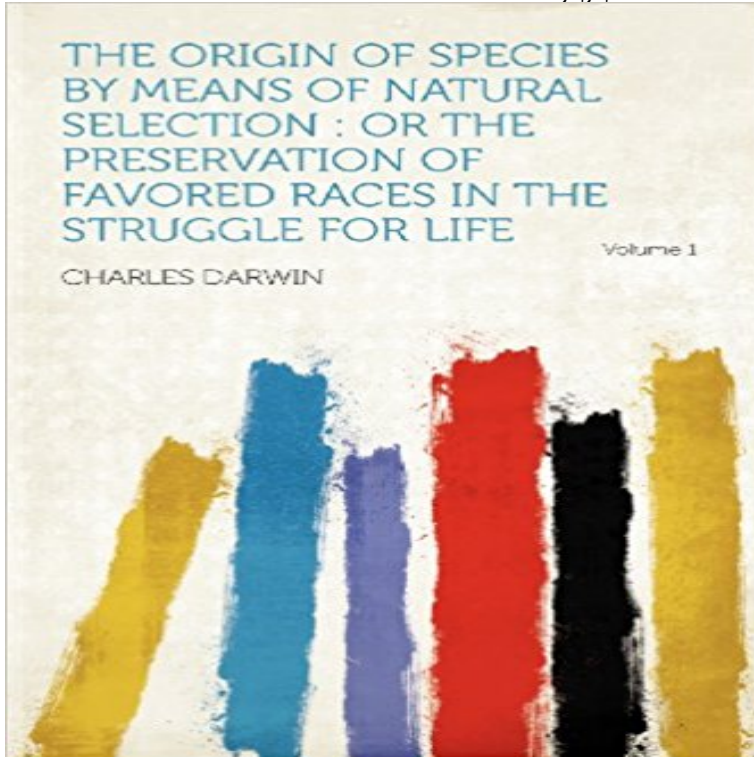


The Origin of Species by Means of Natural Selection: or the Preservation of Favored Races in the Struggle for Life Volume 1
