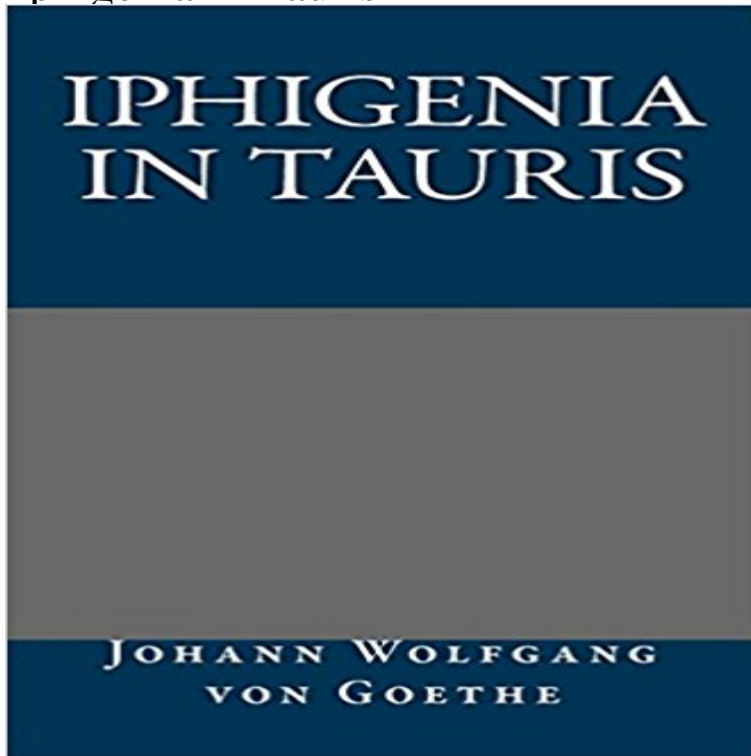


Iphigenia in Tauris
