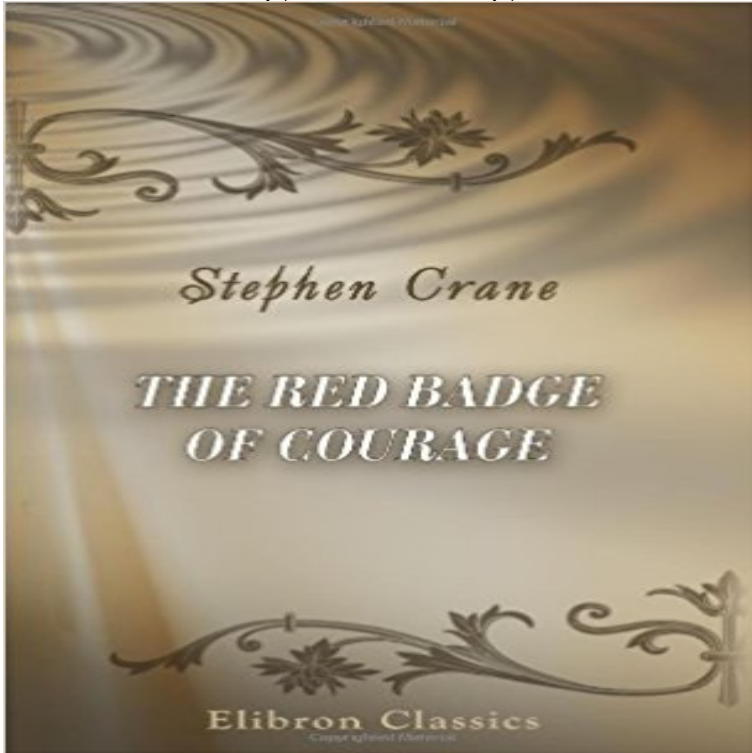


## The Red Badge of Courage
