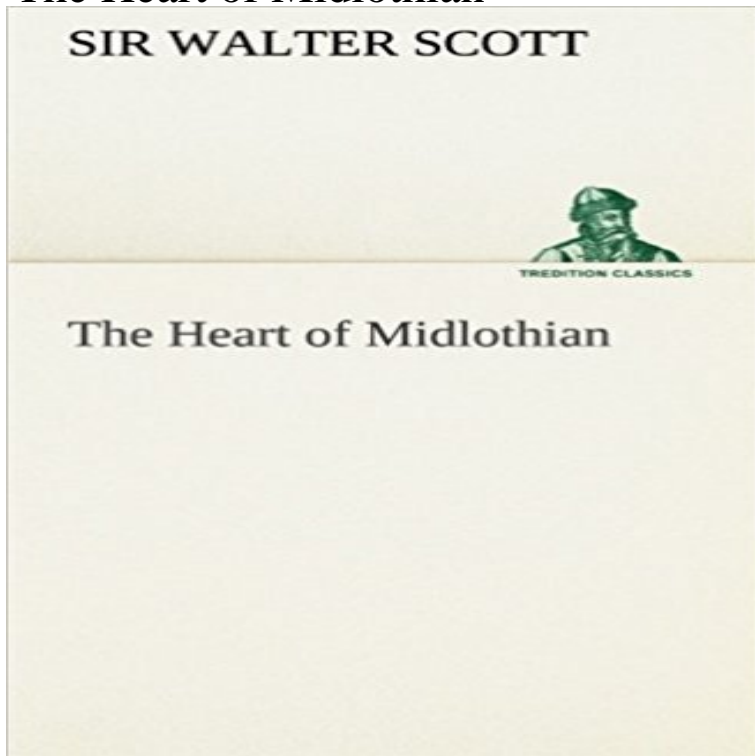


The Heart of Midlothian
