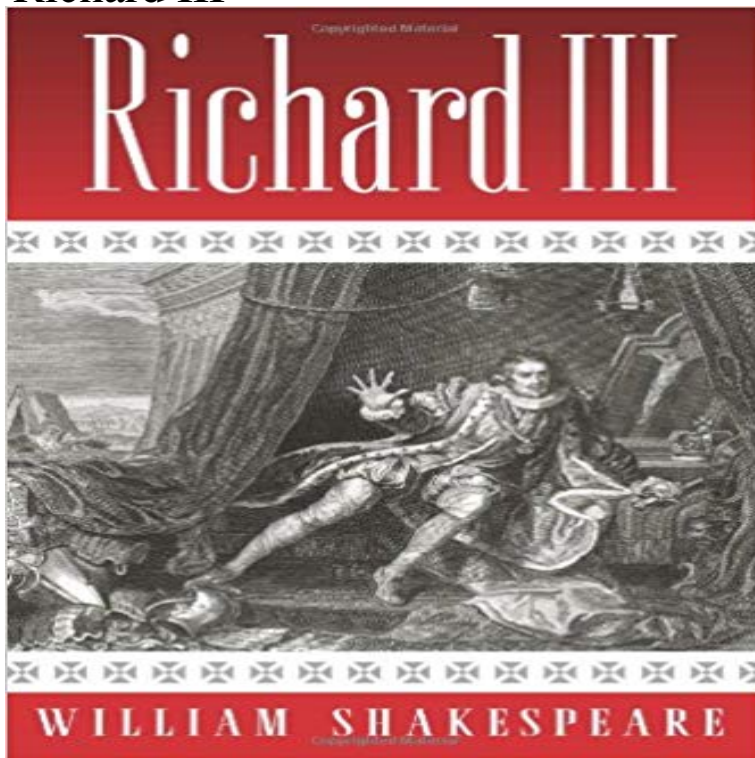


Richard III



Both a tragedy and historical play, Richard III tells the story of a nobleman whose Machiavellian rise to power secures his short reign as king of England. Occurring after the events of Henry VI, parts 1-3, Richard III is notable for completing Shakespeares first tetralogy and is the longest of his stage plays after Hamlet. As a play that touches upon many grave themes, including fate and determinism, Richard III remains notable for its comedic elements and is still celebrated as one of Shakespeares most versatile and ambitious works.
